Speed Problem Resolution

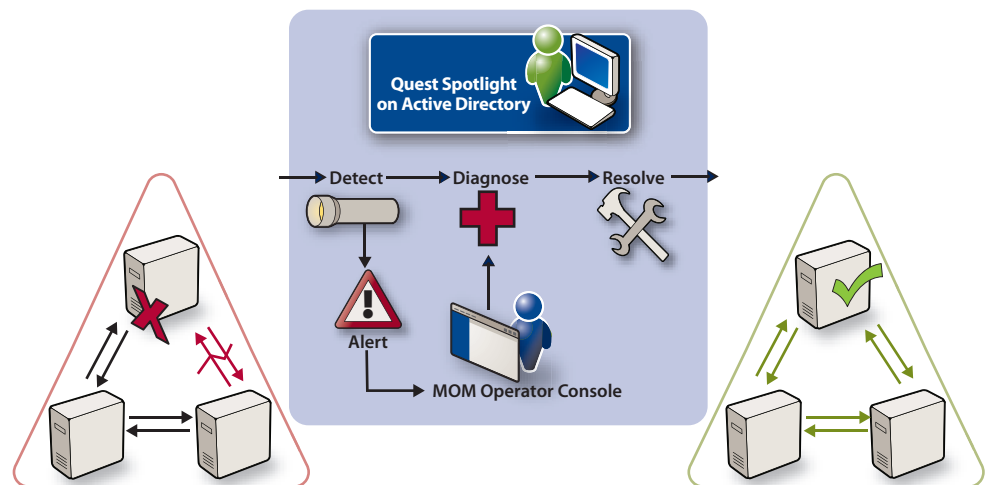

Live Topology View: Spotlight's Live Topology View displays the entire AD site and replication infrastructure. It visually indicates where replication, performance and availability problems exist in the environment. View an entire AD forest at a glance, view links between AD domain controllers, and quickly locate and troubleshoot AD problems with a simple green=good and red=bad paradigm. The Live Topology View enables you to view the specific sections of AD, on which you are focusing diagnostics, and to access views by the FSMO role.

Unified Diagnostic Console: Spotlight's Unified Diagnostic Console visually represents the flow of data from the network and through a domain controller using flow charts, graphs and icons. In this consolidated view of system status, resource bottlenecks are highlighted in yellow and red, and you can drill down on alerts for expert help and resolution suggestions.

Comprehensive Analysis Tests: Spotlight's analysis tests allow you to analyze the core processes of AD, enterprise wide, to ensure that they are functioning properly. The tests automate what would be dozens of manual steps, into a single intelligent analysis. They generate immediate feedback in the Live Topology View and ensure that domain controller status is healthy, and core AD processes, such as directory and file replication and time synchronization, are working properly.

Integration with Microsoft Operations Manager 2005: Spotlight's integration with MOM 2005 streamlines the process of determining the root cause of issues within AD and facilitates quicker resolution, by providing additional context into the MOM Operator Console. In turn, this provides you with a consolidated view of diagnostic and performance data.

Web-Based Trending Reports: Spotlight's Web-based reports trend analysis data over time, highlighting problem areas with key AD processes, such as directory replication, DNS and domain controller performance. Spotlight's reports enable you to identify trouble areas in your AD environment and resolve them before they impact clients.

Integrated DNS Diagnostics: Spotlight's DNS health analysis test checks all the necessary conditions to determine if DNS is healthy and responsive, and that domain controllers are properly configured to use DNS. Given the reliance of AD on a healthy DNS, Spotlight's integrated DNS diagnostics provide administrators with a single interface, to ensure that both AD and DNS are functioning properly. **xxxxx:** To make password resets easy, administrators can update the Windows Logon screen to display a button for users to click and reset their passwords prior to logon. This eliminates the need to configure public kiosks or expensive telephone-based systems and compatibility. Most third-party GINAs or GINA extensions ensures simple deployment
